Closing for Inventory

As everyone is aware, starting in January, we will be utilizing the Asilomar Accords for reporting our animal statistics. In order to start this practice, we need to have an accurate beginning inventory. Therefore, we will be closing both facilities Thursday, December 7 and Friday, December 8 to do a physical count of all animals in our care. Our animal control officers will still be on the road, bringing in stray animals to our Northside facility and will be utilizing the garage to house those animals until our inventory is complete. Our dispatch staff will also be answering calls on those days.

We need everyone's complete attention to detail during the inventory process. It is important that all animal numbers in the system match the animals we have physically in our facilities. Once the physical inventory is complete, we will have some staff members go through our Pet Point system to match those animals. During that process, other staff members will be deep cleaning both facilities so when we open on Saturday the 9th we can all feel good about how both facilities look and smell!

We will be going into greater detail in staff meetings prior to December 7th. All questions can be answered at that time.
