But as Princess Charlotte returned to the **SPCA Cincinnati**, she again found hope in the kindness of supporters like you.

We set about addressing her medical needs. Charlotte needed surgery to relieve her of the badly injured leg. But she was simply too weak to go under anesthesia. She went into foster care to receive love and good nutrition to help her build up her muscle and gain weight.

Her foster parents also made sure she had plenty of exercise, helping her get stronger and healthier as she awaited her surgery. And when it was time, the surgery was a success!
