

### Ben, Where Are My W-2s?!

. . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . .

Form W-2 reports taxable wages paid to an employee during a oneyear period, along with employment taxes withheld from paychecks for that year. Federal law requires all employers to send employees W-2 statements either electronically, or by paper, by the deadline of January 31st. The SPCA Cincinnati sends this form our by paper. Please allow 3-7 business days after the 31st for your W-2 to arrive. Thanks!



We recently received a #HappyTails update on the handsome Walker (now Max)! Please read below to see what Ellen (Max's new mom) had to say about him:


"Hi!! My family and I recently adopted a cute pup with a chicken wing named Walker (now Max). He was a Raising Cane's Chicken dog!
