## SPCA CINCINNATI RESCUES 120 ANIMALS FROM LOUISIANA



"You can do something big, or you can do something small. Because whatever you do, it is better than nothing at all."

On Monday October 11th, we received **120 animals** at Lunken Airport from Louisiana.

Although we received 130 animals in September, the shelters down south continue to experience space shortages as a direct result of Hurricane Ida. Without our help, many of these animals would have face uncertain futures and may have even be euthanized. The 80 cats, and 40 dogs, that have since been transported to our shelter, will be available after they receive medical clearance from our veterinary team.

Rescue missions like these, are not possible, without each and every one of **you**. To every employee, volunteer, board member, sponsors, and news partners- **THANK YOU**! We could not do this work without your help.



Please advise that the availability of each animal will be contingent on medical clearance.

Once cleared, we will post them on our website for the public. If you know of a friend, family or acquaintance who is looking to adopt, send them our way!

Always strive to learn something new and be willing to listen to different perspectives.




