#### Pet Tip of the Week -

**Thunderstorms!** With spring time comes storms, and many animals HATE thunder and lightning (sky booms are scary). Here are some tips to help (with a training tip coming next week):

- Have a quiet area set up with beds and blankets that is away from windows and doors
- Play some calming music
- Invest in a thunder shirt
- If your pet shows extreme signs of anxiety, you may want to consider talking to your vet about medication or calming chews

#### Training Tip of the Week: Leash

**Biting!** This is a behavior often exhibited by shelter dogs and can be quite frustrating! Many times, dogs bite at the leash out of play, frustration, or overstimulation. So how do we fix this? There's a lot of approaches since each dog is different, so here is something to try! • <u>Take a rope toy on your walk</u>: If the dog is having a great time pulling on the leash while you try to get it back, chances are they are just playing a good ol' game of tug-of-war. Instead of forcing your dog to drop the leash and walk nicely, try taking a rope toy to trade them.
